

Art and Language

Objective:

- Learning art and journalism through our newspapers, and the part they play in our daily lives.

Teacher Materials:

- Various newspapers.

Classroom Materials Needed:

- Laurentien® coloured pencils, markers, rulers, newspaper print paper.

Curriculum:

- Art and Language — Creating a newspaper.
Ask students to bring in newspapers, focusing on sports, living, or general news sections. Discuss newspapers and their daily usage; to bring us information on news, sports, weather, and community events. Point out the layout of the newspaper, incorporating the story with pictures.

Give the students two to four “story headlines”, i.e.:

Weather: Tornado swept through oceanfront town.

Local News: New baby lion at the zoo.

Sports: Basketball team scores another victory.

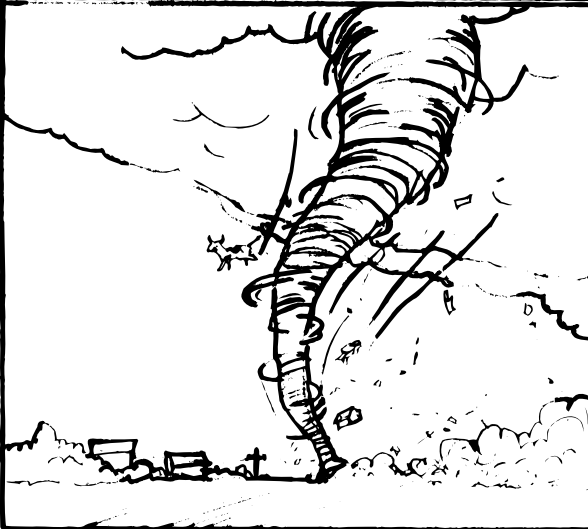
National News: Prime Minister gets a new airplane.

Ask students to divide their paper into four sections using a ruler. In each section, using their Laurentien® coloured pencils and markers, they will draw scenes depicting the various news articles.

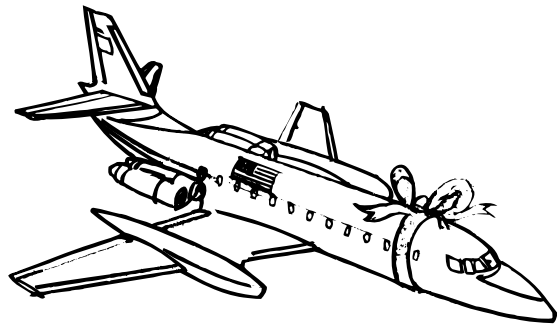
